Deposit/Payments/Policies

All rates are quoted in CDN funds. Payment is to be made in cash, Visa or MasterCard; no personal cheques. Deposits required per person for fishing - \$300.00 CDN. Deposits are required with all reservations and are NOT refundable. Trip payment is to be made prior to departure to the outpost camp. All prices subject to change without notice. Special group rates are available for groups over 12 persons.

Additional Charges

- Canadian federal and provincial taxes
- any food and beverages supplied as per your request

All damage to equipment or camp will be the responsibility of party and payable at time of departure. Overloads and extra flights will be charged at current air charter rates.

For reasons of safety and government regulation, our aircraft are operated according to the manufacturer's specifications. This means *all* guests must ensure they don't bring more gear than is required. The weight limit per person including beverages and groceries, is 100 lbs. Any extra gear or luggage may be assessed a fee for delivery if a special trip must be made.

What to bring fishing:

- spare line
- well-equipped tackle box
- cooler
- mosquito repellent
- flashlight
- sunglasses
- waterproof matches
- compass
- pillow
- sleeping bag
- towels and face cloth
- camera
- filet knife and wet stone
- small first aid kit
- pliers, crescent wrench,
- screwdriver and vice grips
- axe, saw
- life jacket
- rain gear
- dishcloth and towels
- toilet paper
- personal needs
